### **Summary of By-Election**

#### Vacancy

The November 1, 1994, resignation of Harry De Jong, the Member for the Abbotsford Electoral District, created a vacancy in the membership of the Legislative Assembly.

### **Voter Registration**

In preparation for the conduct of the by-election a number of voter registration initiatives were undertaken. Voter registration booths were set up at eight locations with high pedestrian traffic for two weekends in January. 1,039 new voters were registered and 806 registered voters submitted changes of address. Targeted enumerations were conducted in selected subdivisions. New registrations or updates to the voters list were taken at just 11.1% of all residences visited and enumerators made no contact with residents on 39.7% of their calls.

Also during this period a province-wide voter registration/information campaign was conducted by way of direct mail to all British Columbia households. For Abbotsford, prior to the by-election registration cut-off, a further 1,991 registrations and updates to the voters list were received. Through these initiatives we were also able to confirm for 6,068 voters that their registration was current.

Staff in the office of the Registrar of Voters conducted a telephone canvass of residents in the Cultus Lake and Columbia Valley areas. Out of 1,936 households called, contact was made with 1,240 resulting in 1,035 confirmations of registration, 253 updates of registration, and 221 requests for registration forms. 101 households advised us that they did not wish to participate.

### The Electoral Event

On April 5, 1995, pursuant to Order in Council 386, a Writ of Election was issued by the Chief Electoral Officer to Stan Forbes, the Returning Officer for the Abbotsford Electoral District. The Writ ordered that an election be held on May 3, 1995.

Friday, April 21, 1995, was designated as the day for the nomination of candidates; early voting in the office of the Returning Officer commenced on Saturday, April 22, 1995; and four consecutive days of advance voting began on Wednesday, April 26, 1995.

13,166 voters voted in by-election. Voter turnout was 44.07%.

### **Official Results**

The official results for the by-election were announced by the Returning Officer on Monday, May 8, 1995. John van Dongen, endorsed by the Liberal Party of British Columbia, was declared duly elected as the Member to represent the Abbotsford Electoral District in the Legislative Assembly.

Upon return of the Writ of Election and the Certificate of Election from the Returning Officer on May 19, 1995, the Chief Electoral Officer confirmed to the Deputy Attorney General the election of Mr. van Dongen.


